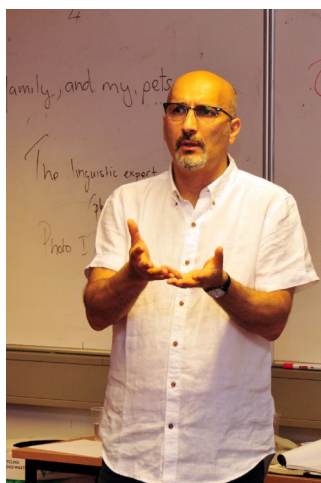
Please note that this is a 6-hour workshop spread over four 90-minute sessions. You should attend at least 3 of the sessions to get the most out of the workshop.

Even though I aim to offer quite a bit of food for reflection and discussion, the sessions are eminently designed to be eminently practical. I will endeavor to demonstrate several activities, which hopefully the participants will want to use with their own students. Most activities require very little preparation, and are easy to set up and fun to do in class.
